Study for your Certification as a Certified Professional Coder (CPC) through our 81 hour Professional Medical Coding Curriculum (PMCC) by The American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC). **CPC Exam:** Is a separate course fee of \$250 and date will be announced. **Workforce Application:** Skills acquired will apply to coding jobs in physicians' offices. At the completion of the course students will be eligible to sit for the Certified Professional Coder (CPC) exam for the CPC-A. Upon successful completion of the exam, those having two years of coding experience will achieve the CPC certification. Those without two years experience will be CPC-Apprentices (CPC-A). One year of experience may be substituted with this course to earn your CPC Credential.
