Study for your Certification as a Certified Professional Coder (CPC) through our 81 hour Professional Medical Coding Curriculum (PMCC) by The American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC).

Workforce Application: Skills acquired will apply to coding in physicians' offices or billing companies. At the completion of the course you will be eligible to take the Certified Professional Coder (CPC) exam for the CPC-A. Upon successful completion of the exam, those having two years of coding experience will achieve the CPC certification. Those without two years experience will be CPC-Apprentices (CPC-A). One year of medical office or coding experience may be substituted with this course to earn your CPC Credential.

Prerequisite: Medical Terminology/Anatomy and Physiology Course or knowledge of medical terminology.
